CAC2 Sustainability: By-Laws

- CAC2 by-laws limit Board service to no more than two consecutive full terms.
- CAC2 President Vickie Buenger and Treasurer Steve Pessagno will reach the end of their second consecutive full term in **June 2021**.
- Neither will be eligible for re-election for the 2021-24 Board election under current By-Laws of the organization.



CAC2 Sustainability: Operations and Financial Stability

- As President, Vickie's role encompassed <u>BOTH</u> board leadership and day-to-day operations management.
- As Treasurer, Steve's role encompassed <u>BOTH</u> establishing short- and long-term financial stability and leading development efforts to fund CAC2 operations.
- Both Steve and Vickie are <u>VOLUNTEERS</u> and have performed these duties in addition to holding their respective full-time paid jobs.



CAC2 Sustainability: Leadership Transition

- Leadership transition can be disruptive if not managed effectively.
- To mitigate disruption in the ongoing CAC2 mission, the Board began to develop a smooth, transparent, and timely transition plan – dating back to January 2020.
- A Leadership Succession Planning team initiated mid-2020, and continues to deliver the plan.

Leadership Succession Deliverables


(1) Change CAC2 By-Laws to reflect two specific changes to structure of Board of Directors.

- Requires approval of two thirds of CAC2 Voting Members entitled to vote at any meeting after notice of such purpose has been given.
- We will do the vote at the Members' Business Meeting at this year's Annual Summit, in June.
- (2) Hire a Managing Director for CAC2.
- (3) Execute the transition plan for BoD changes and onboarding plan for the Managing Director.

Current CAC2 Governance Model





CAC2 Board of Directors: Future State as of 1-Jul-2021



The Executive Committee is composed of 5 Directors from the Board

The CAC2 Operations Manager (Loren Thornburg) will report to the Managing Director. Loren's role is contracted at ~ 10 hours per week.

- 17 applicants, all via word of mouth from CAC2 members and across the childhood cancer community (no recruitment expenses).
 - Phone-screened 11
 - Interviewed 4
- Offer has been accepted, and the Managing Director will start on April 19.
 - Stay tuned for future communication introducing you to our first employee!
- IMPORTANT: The CAC2 Managing Director role is different from a traditional Executive Director role for a non-profit.



ROLE DESCRIPTION: Strategic Direction and Leadership

- Work with the Board and Executive Committee to maintain a clear vision, defined purpose, and core values of the organization.
- Coordinate with the Board Chair to implement a dynamic strategic planning process every 3 years and maintain active engagement to achieve short- and long-term objectives and goals.
- Support the Board President in developing a dynamic plan for Board recruitment, development, and accountability.
- Facilitate dialogue and collaboration among Board members, Interest Groups, and Committees promoting the active participation of members in the CAC2's activities.
- Consult and liaise with the Board on how the organization can continue to provide proactive value-added services to enhance the membership and the childhood cancer community.



ROLE DESCRIPTION: Operations and Development Mgt

- Demonstrate substantive knowledge regarding the organization's programs and services.
- Analyze member feedback to ensure that programs and organizational outreach is consistent with evolving member needs.
- Work closely with the Finance and Development team to develop and implement long-range funding and needs plans to ensure adequate financial assets for the future management and development of the organization.
- In partnership with the Finance and Development team (led by the Treasurer), ensure the integrity of the budgeting process and the implementation of financial policies and procedures.
- Maintain effective communications with membership.
- Coordinate the management of the organization's Annual Summit national meeting.
- Facilitate direction of the monthly all-member webinars.
- Participate in the planning, management, and production of the Annual Report.
- Ensure standing Committees and Interest Groups are effectively carrying out their charges and aligning their work with CAC2's mission and vision.



ROLE DESCRIPTION: External Relations

- Promote and facilitate transparency, collaboration, and open communication among the CAC2 members to build strong, cooperative relationships.
- Manage the processes, procedures, and guidelines to build out an effective external relations structure for the long-term success of the organization.
- Develop and execute on strategies to increase the membership and member value proposition for CAC2 to ensure alignment with the mission and organizational values.
- Monitor member recruitment and retention engagement opportunities to ensure increased participation.
- Serve as an effective public advocate for children with cancer, survivors, their families, and their caregivers.
- Strategize with the Board on initiatives to build brand awareness for the organization.
- Forge beneficial working relationships internally with members as well as externally with health care and industry partners.



Deliverable (3): Execute Transition and Onboarding Plans





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CAC2 Board Nomination Principles

First-term board members have the option to stand for re-election at the end of their terms for a 2nd consecutive 3-year term.

CAC2 Board is a working board (no paid positions), making it important to assemble a diverse set of backgrounds and skills to set and implement an effective strategy for the Coalition, its members, and the kids and families the CAC2 membership serve.



2021 Board of Directors Nomination Process

- In April and May, the Executive Committee of the CAC2 Board of Directors will assess nominations for this year's annual election of the Board of Directors.
- Candidates selected for the slate will be announced in the CAC2 June Announcements.
- Voting will be conducted at the Members' Business Meeting in conjunction with the Annual Summit, in June.
- Only Individual Members and the Voting Representative from Childhood Cancer Organization Members are eligible to vote.
- Written voting proxies are allowed for members not in attendance at the members' business meeting at the Annual Summit in June.
- Each member of CAC2 entitled to vote shall indicate support for, or opposition to, the slate of nominees.



Current Board of Directors 5 seats will be open for election of new Board members. 1 seat is eligible for re-election.






CAC2 and the ICRP DATABASE

ICRP Growth by the Numbers (2015-2018)

Since 2015, the number of childhood cancer projects in the ICRP portfolio has MORE THAN DOUBLED due in large part to the addition of CAC2 member projects.
