# What is the World Cafe

- The World Café is a group process to engage a whole system, in this case our Members, in conversations that matter.
- You are invited to a structured conversation hosted in small groups by current and incoming CAC2 Board Members. Each small group discusses the same topic.
- After a short (18 minute) conversation, participants will switch breakout rooms. Their new host will introduce the previous discussion points at their new table and initiate a new round of conversations.
- The World Café process can bring to light the collective intelligence of everyone and potentially identify linkages and network connections.

# Roles and Etiquette

**CAC2 Leadership**--poses the conversational topic

**Café Host**—welcomes everyone and explains the process

**Table Hosts**—host the conversation, repeats the conversational prompt, help everyone contribute, take notes or appoint a note taker, keep time or appoint a time keeper (so everyone has a chance to add their input)

**Participants**—listen and contribute insights and observations
