Dr. Karres is the Scientific Officer of the Pediatrics Medicines Office of the European Medicines Agency (EMA), a position he has held since 2018. Previously he worked at the United Kingdom's Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) in the Licensing and Post-marketing Division. Dr. Karres supports the EMA's efforts to foster pediatric drug development and serves on the ACCELERATE Steering Committee, a multi-stakeholder platform aiming to facilitate the acceleration of science driven developments of pediatric oncology drugs through global cooperation and collaboration. He has (co)-authored several scientific articles and policy pieces in peer-reviewed journals and has been an invited speaker at international conferences on the topic of pediatric oncology drug development. Dr. Karres earned his medical degree in pediatric drug development from the University Erlangen/ Nuremberg (Germany) and completed his training in pediatric oncology at the University Hospital Muenster (Germany).

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
