COMMITMENT

EXPECTED BEHAVIOR

- Be respectful and collaborative.
- Express differences professionally.
- Follow venue rules and report safety concerns.

UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR

- Physical assault or threats.
- Disruptive or offensive conduct, including unwelcome photography or recording.

REPORTING

Report incidents to CAC2 staff or Board immediately or email staff@cac2.org.

INVESTIGATION

Reports are confidential and investigated promptly by CAC2 leadership. Safety is the priority.

SANCTIONS

- Verbal warning or removal from event.
- Ban from future events or leadership role
